GIBSONBURG VETERANS MEMORIAL PLAQUES

The Gibsonburg Veteran's Memorial was dedicated on Saturday, September 13, 2003. The lighted brick wall has a total of 1,500 spaces for 2" x 7" bronze plaques which are attached to bricks listing service members' name and their years of service. This wall is located at the northeast corner of North Main and East Stone Street behind the bronze Kneeling Chaplain, which is placed on a raised area with a helmet and dog tag on the gunstock of an inverted rifle and bayonet.

On September 12, 2007, a dedication was held to include a T -33 jet, which overlooks the memorial wall. As of December 2016, more than \$100,000 in donations have been used to commission the kneeling chaplain; to engrave more than 1200 Veteran's names; to engrave memorial bricks along the donor walkway; provide concrete and stone work; install a flag pole, headstone, lighting, chain fencing and benches; as well as update the landscaping.
