- Naturalization Ceremony- For the past several weeks, the school district and village have been working with the US District Court on hosting a Naturalization Ceremony in Gibsonburg. We met with the judge and his staff again this morning and we have finalized Thursday, May 16th at 9:30am for the event. It will take place in the high school gym and will be open to the public. The ceremony will be an actual session of the US District Court where approximately 40 individuals will become Naturalized Citizens of the United States of America. Students of Gibsonburg High School and Middle School will also be present and fully participating in the ceremony. We all feel that this is a great event to host in Gibsonburg and most certainly a very educational event for the students.
